

City of Sedalia Issues Notice of Water Main Repair, Lane Restrictions and Water Boil Advisory for Area Around the Intersection of W. Main Street and S. Grand Ave.

The City of Sedalia will begin repairs on a leaking water valve located in the middle of the intersection at W. Main St. and S. Grand Ave. on Tues., Aug. 25, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. Customers will have their water service impacted if they live along S. Grand Ave. between W. Main St. and W. 2nd St. as well as businesses located at 726, 808 and 812 W. Main St. Water service will need to be shut-off to this area to allow for the repairs or replacement to be made to the leaking valve. The Water Division anticipates repairs will be complete and water service restored by 5:00 p.m. on Tues., Aug 25, 2020. However, a water boil advisory will remain in place for this area until water samples are analyzed on Wed., Aug. 26, 2020. A Public Service Announcement will be released providing notification of removal of the boil advisory.



Lane restrictions will occur as men and heavy equipment will be working in the roadway. Travelers are advised to anticipate delays near this intersection and are encouraged to seek alternate routes to avoid delays on Tues., Aug. 25, 2020.

Upon satisfactory completion of water sampling, the Water Division will provide notification of the lifting of the boil advisory in the area. A Public Service Announcement will be released providing notification of removal of the boil advisory.

Once water service is restored, those customers observing “cloudy” water should flush their water lines by operating external hydrants or flowing water through their bathtubs.

Any customer who notices “cloudy” water should report this to the Sedalia Water Department at (660) 826-1236.
