STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS: CHIP AND SEAL OF STREETS CONTINUES

(SEDALIA, MISSOURI) The City of Sedalia will continue chip and seal on Sedalia streets next week. The following list provides the streets where chip and seal is planned for the week of September 3, 2019. Motorists are encouraged to find alternate routes on the day work is scheduled for a specific street or plan additional time to arrive at their destination as periodic lane closures will occur as equipment and men are working on the streets.

Date: Wed., September 4, 2019

All of Brentwood Ave.

S. Grand Ave. between W. 32nd St. to City Limits

Manor Ct. between S. Grand Ave. to Brentwood Ave.

James Rd. between Clinton Rd. to Heck Ave.

Date: Thurs., September 5, 2019

Driftwood Dr. between Clinton Rd. to Poplar Pl.

Heck Ave. between S. Limit Ave. to Driftwood Dr.

Country Club Dr. between S. Limit Ave. to Greenwood Ln.

Poplar Pl. between Honeysuckle Rd. to Driftwood Dr.

Colonial Ct. between Honeysuckle Rd. to Driftwood Dr.

Stacey Ln. between Highway Dr. to Brandon Ave.

Highway Dr. between W. 32nd St. to Stacey Ln.

Chip and seal is a process that places a coating of road oil on the existing city street followed by a layer of fine crushed rock or “chips”. A roller is then run over the chips to embed some of them into the asphalt and hold the road oil in place. The layer of crushed chips including some loose chips remain on the street to prevent “bleeding” through of the oil to other surfaces, such as vehicles. The remaining loose chips are later swept up, within 7 to 10 days dependent on weather conditions and equipment availability. The chip and seal process “seals” an asphalt roadway and reduces impacts from freezing and

thawing during winter months which result in potholes forming and roadway surfaces failing.

We apologize for any inconvenience as we work to improve the streets in Sedalia. The work contained in this announcement is weather and equipment dependent, so changes may occur from time-to-time.
