A Bidder's Bond for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid must be submitted with the bid as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into a contract with the City if awarded the contract by the Sedalia City Council.

- 4. The work consists of the installation of storm sewers, curb and gutter, driveway repair, water main replacement, erosion control, and all incidental and/or related work as necessary to provide a complete project.
- 5. The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to accept the best bid whether it is or is not the lowest bid and to waive irregularities. The project will be awarded to the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder. No Bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of the bid opening.
- 6. Prevailing Wage, If Applicable (Projects over \$75,000): If the bid submitted for this project is over \$75,000, notice is hereby given that the Contractor and all subcontractors to the Contract:

- Must require all on-site employees to complete the ten-hour construction safety training program required under Section 292.675, RSMo, unless they have previously completed the program and have documentation of having done so.
- Must comply with RSMo 285.530 in relation to employment of unauthorized aliens to perform work within the State of Missouri and will be required to participate in the federal work authorization program.
