First Thursdays - Bouncing & Breaking Goals



As we approach the fifth First Thursday of the season on August 3, 2023, we thank all of the merchants, musicians, artists and vendors who have participated in these events. As a way to gauge the success of these First Thursdays, the Promotion Committee set a goal of having at least 200 people in attendance by the time we reached our last First Thursday on October 5. Our First Thursday in April was well over 200 in attendance and our July First Thursday doubled that! We think it's probably good to set a different goal for October!

Our August First Thursday is themed "Your Big Backyard Party" as we plan on having THREE bounce houses within the 200 block of S. Ohio Avenue and yard games for the kiddos along with all of the fun promotions provided by our downtown merchants, musicians, artists and vendors.

There will also be a pie-eating contest at The Pavilion at 200 South Ohio Avenue!

Our September First Thursday will be a little different as we will ask YOU to participate in the fun. We will be hosting our Trunk to Treasure event around the courthouse square where the public will be allowed to sell items from their trunk (think of it as a car show meets Halloween trunk or treat event). Downtown merchants may hold sidewalk sales outside of their businesses as well. Trunk to Treasure rules and sign up information is soon to follow.



Summer Maintenance Tips

We love our downtown buildings but sometimes maintainng them can be a little daunting. Here's some helpful maintenance tips specific to August and September along with the estimated time it might take to do them.

Remove plants growing on or close to walls and foundation (30 min.)

Visually check for moss or lichen, especially around parapets, sills and downspouts (30 min.)

Check grading at foundation to make sure water will drain away from building and not pool (15 min.)

Inspect basement or crawl space for excessive water during weather (30 min.)

Inspect interior of building for leaks during heavy rains. (30 min.)

Examine roof slope to make sure water is not pooling at any areas on the roof (15 min.)

Make sure water can flow freely through the gutters and downspouts. Clean out if they are clogged (30 min.)

Sweep debris from flat or low sloping roofs (30 min.)

Check weather stripping around windows and doors. Install to prevent air infiltration (1 hour, depending on type).

If applicable, install interior storm windows for winter (2 hours)

Caulk any gaps in wood for a temporary water tight seal (30 min.)


















WELCOME DOWNTOWN
