Working in coordination with and partially funded by the West Central Missouri Solid Waste Management District and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the City of Sedalia is now accepting household hazardous waste for reuse or disposal

The household hazardous waste (HHW) collection trailer is located at the City's Materials Management site at 27882 Highway U. Watch for the signs directing you to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Trailer. Specific directions— Upon entering the Material Management site, drive to the 3rd gravel access drive on the left. The HHW collection trailer is a 53 foot green container.

What are household hazardous wastes?

U.S. EPA considers some leftover household products that can catch fire, react, or explode under certain circumstances, or that are corrosive or toxic to be household hazardous waste or HHW. Improper disposal of HHW can include pouring them down the drain, on the ground, into storm sewers, or in some cases putting them out with the regular trash. The dangers of such disposal methods might not be immediately obvious, but improper disposal of these wastes can pollute the environment and pose a threat to human health.

ONLY RESIDENTIAL HHW IS ACCEPTED. NO BUSINESS OR COMMERCIAL DROP-OFF IS ALLOWED.

What household hazardous waste products are being accepted by the City for reuse or disposal?

Acid, Adhesives, Glues, Aerosol Cans, Ammonia, Antifreeze, Car & Truck Batteries, Bleach, Brake Fluid, Caulk, Car Wax/Cleaners, Charcoal Lighter Fluid, CFCs & HCFCs, Disinfectants, Drain Openers, Fabric Dyes, Fertilizer, Fingernail Polish/Removers, Flea Collars, Furniture Polish/Waxes, Insecticides, Insect Repellants & Poison, Lubricating Oils, Mothballs, Motor Oil, Oil-based Paints, Organic Solvents, Oven Cleaner, Tub/Tile Cleaner, Varnish, Windshield Wiper Fluid, Wood Preservatives, Wood Stain, Paint Stripper, Pesticides Pet Sprays/Dips, Photographic Chemicals, Handheld Rat/Mouse Poisons, Septic Tank Cleaners, Shoe Polishes/Waxes, Spa Care Chemicals, Spot Removers, Swimming Pool Chemicals, Toilet Bowl Cleaners, Transmission Fluid.

Note: Gasoline and kerosene are not taken.
