Historic Clock Dedication Marks a Special Homecoming for Downtown Sedalia

On Monday, July 14, 2025, community members gathered to celebrate the return of Sedalia's historic street clock, first installed in the 1880's by Bichsel's Jewelry at 217 S. Ohio Avenue. The dedication ceremony marked the restoration of a beloved local landmark and honored more than 140 years of downtown history. The original clock location – now home to The Cellar Door – provided a fitting backdrop for the celebration.

Following the ceremony, guests were welcomed inside The Cellar Door for a preview reception hosted by owner Kim Boggs, whose hospitality added a personal touch to the event. City leaders expressed gratitude for the community's role in preserving Sedalia's heritage, calling the clock's return a proud symbol of honoring the past while investing in the City's future!
