All materials need to be placed at the curb or between the sidewalk and street in the greenspace away from overhead lines, poles, trees, mailboxes and vehicles by 5:00 a.m. on the Monday of the area's Clean Sweep Week. Sanitation crews will spend the week collecting and disposing of the materials for that area. In order to ensure all your items are picked up we ask they are placed into the following segregated piles.

YARD WASTE-vegetation, plants, tree debris, branches and leaves, bushes, brush and tree stumps. Please keep branches under 6 ft. in length & no larger than 18 in. diameter	construction & Demolition WASTE -carpet, carpet pads, lumber, dry wall, siding, treated patio lumber, pallets, old windows, and screen doors
UNWANTED JUNK -old furniture, grills, mattresses, patio furniture, outdoor toys, etc.	APPLIANCES-refrigerators, microwaves, stoves, washers/dryers, air conditioners, dishwashers. MUST BE IN A SEPARATE PILE

*****TIRES OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED*****

DUMPSTER RENTAL	BULKY ITEM PICK-UP
The City of Sedalia currently offers 2 yard, 4 yard, 10 yard and 30-yard dumpsters for 3-week rentals (time begins when dumpster is set). No yard waste, tires, concrete, brick, appliances, hazardous waste, or over filling allowed.	The City of Sedalia offers a fee based bulky item trash pick- up for those large items not fitting into your trash carts, but do not require a dumpster rental.

WEEKLY TRASH PICK-UP REMINDERS

- Carts must be set out by 5:00 a.m. and are only permitted out on day of pick up
- Do not over fill the carts or place bags on top of the lid
- Trash must be inside the cart with the lid closed
- Bags should not be placed on the ground next to the cart
- Do not place cart next to vehicles, mailboxes, utility poles or under low lying tree branches
