May is National Preservation Month! Last month, the Sedalia Historic Preservation Commission asked citizens to nominate their favorite historic places within the City for National Historic Landmark status. This month they are asking you to vote for your favorite of the top 6 submitted. Voting began on May 1st and will continue until May 31st.

Many residents nominated buildings/areas that have a special meaning to them, sharing why they thought the building/area should be a historic landmark.

Sedalia Public Library – The library is truly rich in history. It was built in 1900 and is a Carnegie library. It is already listed on the National Register of Historic Places, adding it as a National Historic Landmark would only add to its integrity.

Katy Depot – This historic building was built in 1896 and then completely restored in 2001. The Depot first greeted passengers on the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Rail Line for decades, and now serves as Sedalia’s Welcome Center!

Lamy Building – This building was built in 1893 and was a factory for work apparel. Beginning in 1948, Lamy’s began making jeans for Levi Strauss. Today, it houses restaurants, apartments, offices, and other areas.

Hotel Bothwell – The hotel first opened in 1927. This historic hotel has had several celebrity visitors from politicians to actors! It was a senior living facility for 10 years, but then bought by Doyle Furnell in 1998 and restored to its former glory which is what you see today!

Former Jennie Jaynes Stadium – This Stadium stood for 61 years and held many memories for those who played football or attended games here. The site is currently the home of the Heckart Community Center.

Former Smith-Cotton Hight School – It currently is the Jr. High School. The first year for consolidated grade 9-12 education was the 1925-1926 school year. Many people who commented on the post stated that at least 4 generations of their family attended/graduated from this High School.

As you can see all 6 of these buildings/sites have a rich history and mean a lot to people for different reasons. This will be a difficult vote as you can only vote once!

You can vote at the City’s Facebook page under the post for the “Celebrate Historic Preservation Month” or there will be forms available in the Sedalia Municipal Building’s lobby.

MEMORIAL DAY HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

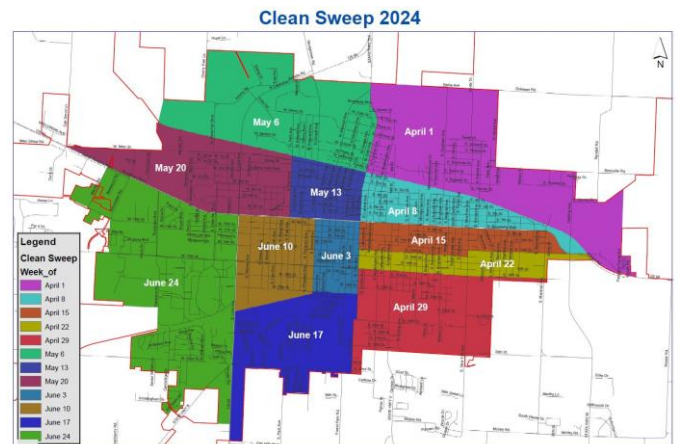
