TSgt. Hollopeter with the 509th Civil Engineer Squadron at Whiteman Airforce Base contacted Dave Gerken, Collections Foreman, with the City of Sedalia's Public Works Department to help his squad become recertified on the dual motor combination vac truck. The Squadron doesn't have a truck of their own and Dave and his crew were honored to be of service to our Airmen.

Dave Gerken, Frankie Vanderpool and David Purl assisted in training the airmen on the different functions of the truck. The truck uses Hydro excavating (water to cut the ground at 7000 psi and using the vacuum to remove soil). The airmen were also trained on using the water jetting portion of the truck and vacuum system.

Dave said they also showed the Squad their camera system which is used to inspect the underground piping (sanitary sewer pipe, and stormwater pipe). They did not need the certification, but were very interested and impressed with the functions and set up of the system. Dave Gerken had the following to say about working with the Squadron: "We had an awesome time, and were honored to be asked and look forward to future training sessions with them. I was very impressed with their enthusiasm and their professionalism."
