Missourians have been coming to Sedalia to attend the State Fair since 1901, which offers 11 days of agriculture, entertainment and family fun! The Fair is, at its heart, an event celebrating the rich agricultural heritage of the Show-Me State.

Last year, the fair was nearly canceled! The only event that was held was the Youth Livestock Show. The Missouri State Fair has survived storms, a depression, several recessions, and now a global pandemic. After last year's near cancellation the Fair will kick off for a full experience on Thursday, August 12 and wraps up on Sunday, August 22.

Opening day will feature a Family Value Day with \$4 adult admission for ages 13+ and a \$2 children admission. There will also be opening day specials at many concession and vendor stands. The opening day parade begins at 6 p.m. with the theme "Our Missouri Celebration" in honor of Missouri's Bicentennial!

The Bicentennial Quilt will be on display at the Womans Building as well as bicentennial merchandise available for purchase. The Missouri 4-H also will have a Bicentennial Quilt on display in the 4-H building! Happy 200th birthday to Missouri!

The Grandstand concerts are back, as well! Trace Adkins with comedian Dusty Slay will kick off the concert series with 8 other concerts to follow! You won't want to miss out this year!

There are several free attractions and entertainments, the children's barnyard and petting zoo, and of course the Midway! So join us in welcoming back the Missouri State Fair and let's make it the best one ever!!
