- Saturday, Dec. 25, 2021 closed
- Friday, Dec. 31, 2021 open from 7:00 a.m. to noon (early close)
- Saturday, Jan. 1, 2022 closed

City offices will re-open for normal business hours after the Christmas holiday on Monday, December 27, 2021 and after the New Year's holiday on Monday, January 3, 2022.
