City of Sedalia to Observe Presidents Day

The City of Sedalia will be closed on Monday, February 21, 2022 in observance of Presidents Day.

Weekly trash pickup for the week of February 21, 2022 will follow the normal collection schedule. The Materials Management Site at 27882 Highway "U" will be closed on Monday, February 21, 2022.

City offices including the Materials Management Site will re-open for normal business hours on Tuesday, February 22, 2022.





Are you spending some of these cold winter days planning what you can do when it's warmer outside? Thinking about hosting a special event in a public space (for example, a block party or downtown event)? Here's some information regarding how to get your permit.

- 1. You can get your permit off the City's website under the Permit & Forms page. You will need to select the Police Department. Then you will see the Special Event Permit link.
- 2. Click the link and fill out the application. You can print out the application and turn it into the SPD Headquarters at 300 West Third Street or you can email it at tzaremba@sedaliapolice.com
- 3. Please read the application thoroughly and file it in a timely manner. Some events need to be filed sooner than others. All parades and 5-K runs should be registered with the Sedalia Police Department at least two weeks in advance. If you're planning an event that will include alcohol, it is best to give yourself several months' preparation. Events including alcohol in public spaces must be submitted for the City of Sedalia Council's approval and copies of city and state permits must be included along with your special event permit. You must also arrange for off-duty security through the Sedalia Police Department.
- 4. Permit must be approved by both the Mayor and Sedalia Police Department.
- 5. Lastly enjoy your event!!
