Did you know that July is National Parks and Recreation month! Our City has many wonderful and historic parks available! There are even a few state parks a short drive from Sedalia. Here are some of the parks and what they have to offer. Consider visiting them this summer.

**Local State Parks:**

- **Bothwell Lodge**  
Tour this historic home and learn about John Homer Bothwell. There are also hiking/biking trails, a picnic area and playground equipment.
- **Katy Trail State Park**  
You can walk, bike or ride your horse on this historic trail! Plus stop and visit/shop at the Historic Katy Depot.

**Sedalia Parks:**

- **Centennial Park**  
Baseball fields, a walking trail and a swimming pool.

- **Clover Dell Park**  
Multiple soccer fields, a dog park, located near the Katy Trail, an 18-hole Frisbee golf course and a fishing pond.
- **Housel Park**  
Basketball court, baseball field and a tiny tot play area.
- **Hubbard Park**  
Celebrates its 100<sup>th</sup> birthday this year, having been donated by Ms. Cotton in 1921! It has a new modular playground area, 2 basketball courts and a lighted baseball field!
- **Katy Park**  
Baseball field, soccer field, walking trail and a skate park.
- **Liberty Park**  
Basketball courts, tennis courts, volleyball courts, swimming pool, fishing pond, and the Liberty Land Flyer Train.
- **Vermont Park**  
Basketball courts, multi-courts, and a walking trail.

All parks offer playground equipment and picnic shelters!!
