

# A Map of Clean Sweep Collection Areas is available on the City website at: http://www.sedalia.com/content/11298/11388/26913.

All materials need to be placed at the curb or between the sidewalk and street in the greenspace away from overhead lines and trees by 6:00 a.m. on the Monday of the area's Clean Sweep Week. Sanitation crews will spend the week collecting and disposing of the materials for that area. We are asking residents to place materials in segregated piles as shown in the diagram below.

**Yard Waste** includes vegetation, plants, tree debris, such as branches and leaves, bushes, brush and tree stumps.

**C & D Waste** includes carpet, carpet pads, lumber, dry wall, siding, treated patio lumber, pallets, old windows and screen doors.

**Appliances** are banned from landfills in Missouri will need to be segregated. Please keep any appliances such as refrigerators, washers/dryers, microwaves, ranges, window air conditioners, or dishwashers separated out.

# TEMPORARY DUMPSTER/CONTAINER RENTAL

Do you have a pile of junk (i.e., trash) sitting around the house, yard, or garage? Is it time for a face-lift around the house -- a new bathroom or kitchen? Wondering what to do with this junk and materials, a good low cost alternative is renting a temporary dumpster. Book a temporary residential roll-off dumpster. We have a range of sizes to suit most any job. Just call (660) 827-7820 between 7:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to arrange for delivery and pick-up of a dumpster.

**Dumpster Fees:** For residential junk/trash are based on size, number of loads and rental period. Minimum charge for a two cubic yard dumpster is \$30.20 and reduces for each additional load (\$21.20 per 2 cubic-yard load). For construction and demolition waste \$39.75 for two cubic yards and \$30.75 for each additional 2-cubic yard load.

# **BULKY ITEM PICK-UP SERVICE**

UNWANTED JUNK

Have an item or two to dispose off that won't fit in your trash cart? We can help you with a bulky item trash pick-up. Items that fit this service include:

- \* Appliances (i.e., refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, washers, dryers, water heaters)
- \* Furniture (i.e., sofa, chair, table, bed frame, microwave cart, mattresses and box/innersprings)
- \* Other large items not fitting in your trash cart

# Fee for Bulky Item Pick-up On Demand:

\$30.20 per cubic yard. Minimum charge for each pick-up is one cubic yard.
