



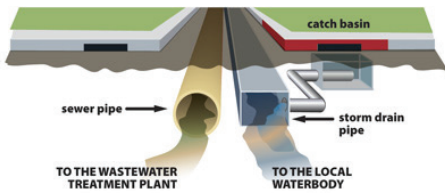

Do's



- Stormwater drains direct rainwater to streams which is why no chemicals, oil, trash, etc. should be placed in any stormwater drain.



- Always be sure that no sewer lines (or other illicit connections) are tied-into storm drains.



- If any work is performed that will produce erosion, sediment, or waste to be washed down the stormwater drain, appropriate controls and permits must be in place.

Don'ts



- Don't dump yard waste/trash into a stormwater drain.



- Don't dump chemicals, oil, paint, etc. into stormwater drains. Drains are only meant for water.



- Don't leave trash on roadways/parking lots where it will be washed into a storm drain. Instead, place all trash in an appropriate trash/recycling bin.
