# **About The Bus**

### **Hours of Service**

- Monday thru Friday: 6:30 AM to 5:30 PM
- Saturday: 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM
- Sunday: Closed

### SAVE MONEY! Buy Punch Cards for \$1.25 per ride

## Hours of Service, Continued:

We **start and stop** all routes Monday thru Saturday at Kmart in the State Fair Shopping Center (Transfer Stop).

We are **closed** on major holidays and during inclement weather.

The **Route A** bus stops at each location on the route every 30 minutes.

The **Route B** bus stops at each location on the north and south routes every 60 minutes but stops at the **transfer stop** every 30 minutes.

The **Saturday** bus stops at each location on the Saturday route every 60 minutes. There is only one bus route on Saturdays.

### **Bus Fares**

**Cash.** Rides of all services listed on this schedule are **\$1.50 cash** per person per ride, but kids 12 and under ride for **50¢.** Kids must be accompanied by an adult.

**Prepaid Punch Cards.** Anyone may purchase prepaid punch cards and save 25¢ per ride.

### \$20 for 16 rides

Cards may be purchased from the Sedalia City Bus driver, at the OATS office, or may be obtained through some local agencies. Cards are transferable and can be used by whoever has it in their possession. Multiple riders can use a Card at the same or different times—the Card will be punched once per rider per ride regardless of who is using it or the number of riders using it at the time. Up to two kids may ride as one adult on the Card—two kids, one Card punch.

#### Cards should be treated as cash and are nonrefundable. Lost or stolen cards will not be replaced.

Transfers are free from Route A to Route B or from Route B to Route A. No transfer tickets are required.

## **On Time**

Although we strive to stay on time for each of our stops, we may run **up to 10 minutes late** from time to time due to unforeseen reasons. We appreciate your patience and

cooperation while we work to get back on schedule. We may also **run up to 5 minutes early** at some stops. Please plan your trips accordingly.

### ADA Accessible Service & Deviated Stops

For riders who need assistance, Accessible Service is available by making a pick up request at least one day in advance. In addition to boarding the bus at the specified stops listed on this bus schedule, riders can request to be picked up or dropped off—at the curb—up to 3/4 of a mile off route.

ADA and Deviated Stop **pick up** requests must be made at least one day in advance by calling us and are subject to approval by OATS and are also subject to availability on a first-come, first-served basis. Reservations for Saturday pick ups must be made before 4:30 PM Fridays.

Requests for **drop offs** at a deviated stop may be made in advance by calling us, or by simply asking your driver when you get on the bus. Requests to get off the bus at deviated stops are subject to availability on a first-come, first served basis and may be delayed at the driver's discretion in order to stay on time. It is at the driver's discretion to determine whether a stop is safe and legal.

These services are available during the same Hours of Service and at the same Fares as described on this schedule.

### **Seat Belts**

All riders must properly use a seat belt at all times the bus is moving—there are no exceptions.

**Children and Child Safety Seats.** Adult riders are required to provide and properly use child safety seats for children under 4 years old or older children under 40 pounds. Child safety seats and children must remained properly secured at all times when the vehicle is moving.

Children between 4 and 8 years old and weighing more than 40 pounds may use a booster seat, provided by the adult rider, with a lap and shoulder belt; otherwise the child may sit directly on the bus seat and use the lap belt provided. 9.00

Child safety seats and booster seats must be approved by the USDOT under FMVSS rules and must not be expired (expirations dates are stamped on the seats).

## **Ridership Courtesy**

**Space may be limited.** We know that many of our riders purchase groceries and other items and our drivers want to help as much as they can, but the bus drivers are not allowed to help you with your packages to or from the vehicle. Riders are limited to the number and size of packages at the bus driver's sole discretion. Please check with the bus driver before making large purchases that you need to take on the bus.

**Help our drivers stay on time.** We want you to enjoy your ride on the bus, but we want to be sure other riders also enjoy the ride. Please be ready to board when the bus arrives, be courteous and remain seat-belted while on board, and be ready to get off the bus at your stop.

**All stops must be safe.** Flag stops are permitted on route, as long as they are safe and legal. If any stop is deemed to be unsafe or illegal for any reason, the driver must continue to the next safe and legal stop. It is at the driver's discretion to determine whether a stop is safe and legal.

### **Community Involvement**

**Community Transportation Partnership** (CTP) oversees the Sedalia City Bus and partners with OATS to operate the service. The CTP committee meets periodically throughout the year. You are invited to attend and share your ideas with us. If you'd like to attend a meeting, please call OATS (660-827-2611) and we can let you know when and where the next meeting will be held.






