All pets are examined by a licensed veterinarian prior to adoption. Fees for adoption include: initial vaccinations, spay/neuter, and microchip.

The adoption fees are as follows:

Adoption	Fee
Feline - cat	\$35.00
Feline - kitten (1 year and younger)	\$45.00
Canine - adult mixed breed dog	\$55.00 to \$150.00
Canine - adult small breed dog	\$85.00 to \$150.00
Canine - puppy (1 year and younger)	\$85.00 to \$150.00
Hold provision	\$40.00

Love animals but don't want to adopt a pet? Friends of our furbabies find other ways they can help, whether it's through donations, volunteering, or sharing pet information through social media. Our shelter strives to be the best it can be every day because we have the best people backing us and the best of pets depending on us.

The City of Sedalia will observe the Labor Day holiday on Monday, September 6, 2021. Offices in the Municipal Building and the City's Materials Management Site at 27882 Highway "U" will be closed in observance of the holiday.

All City offices including the Materials Management Site will re-open for normal business hours on Tuesday, September 7, 2021.
